* * The indicated tuition fee for acquiring a Specialist's degree and a Master's degree covers the whole period of training (except the educational program "Medicine")

The tuition fee for full-time studies in a postgraduate program regardless of the school and speciality is equivalent to 3,500 (three thousand five hundred) US dollars a year. The tuition fee for part-time studies in a postgraduate program regardless of the school and speciality is equivalent to 2,450 (two thousand four hundred fifty) US dollars a year.

The tuition fee for full-time studies in a doctoral program regardless of the school and speciality is equivalent to 5,000 (five thousand) US dollars a year.

Traineeship of higher education professionals:

- natural sciences — equivalent to 250 (two hundred fifty) US dollars a month;
- the Humanities — equivalent to 200 (two hundred) US dollars a month;
- organization of groups for foreign citizens (except those from the CIS countries) of language behavior and adaptation in language traineeship in terms of acquisition of language skills of the Russian and Ukrainian business languages of the community — equivalent to 600 (six hundred) US dollars a year, without providing accommodations and with a certificate awarded upon completion of the Preparatory Division of the Center for International Education.
